Community Grant Program: School Project Funding Criteria

August 2019

School projects must be directed at educating students about native plants or plant communities in the Lowcountry of South Carolina (specifically, we will only consider projects in Beaufort, Berkeley, Charleston, Colleton, Dorchester, Georgetown, and Horry Counties). Priority will be given to those projects involving cultural significance, rare species, or the removal of invasive/exotic species. Events occurring during South Carolina Native Plant Week (October 12-19, 2019) will also be considered.

Requirements:

- Applicants must demonstrate that they have means (manpower, time, etc.) available to complete and maintain the project.
- Applicant must provide documentation that permission has been granted by the school for the project. Awardees are required to provide proof of project completion, such as photos and maps (if applicable), of the funded project upon completion (or within one year of the issue date).
- After completion, a tour or presentation about the project during one of the SCNPS Lowcountry monthly meetings at the Citadel is required.
- Funds must be used within one year of issuance. Applicants may only apply for one project per fiscal year.

For consideration, **applicants must submit a one-page description of the project** that includes

- a. Project contact (including phone number and email address)
- b. Location
- c. Budget (include any matching funds)
- d. Description of how this project benefits or demonstrates the value of native plants.
- e. Discussion of whom the project will affect and how.
- f. Timeline for completion
- g. Description of how project will be sustained/maintained over time
- h. Letters of support from identified partners and/or landowners

Award amounts: Individual award amounts will not exceed \$500. Awards will be given at the discretion of the Board of the Lowcountry Chapter of the SCNPS.

Application deadlines:

Fall proposals will be accepted until **Friday, September 13th** and awarded by October 1st.

Spring proposals will be accepted until **Friday, February 14th** and awarded by March 1st.
